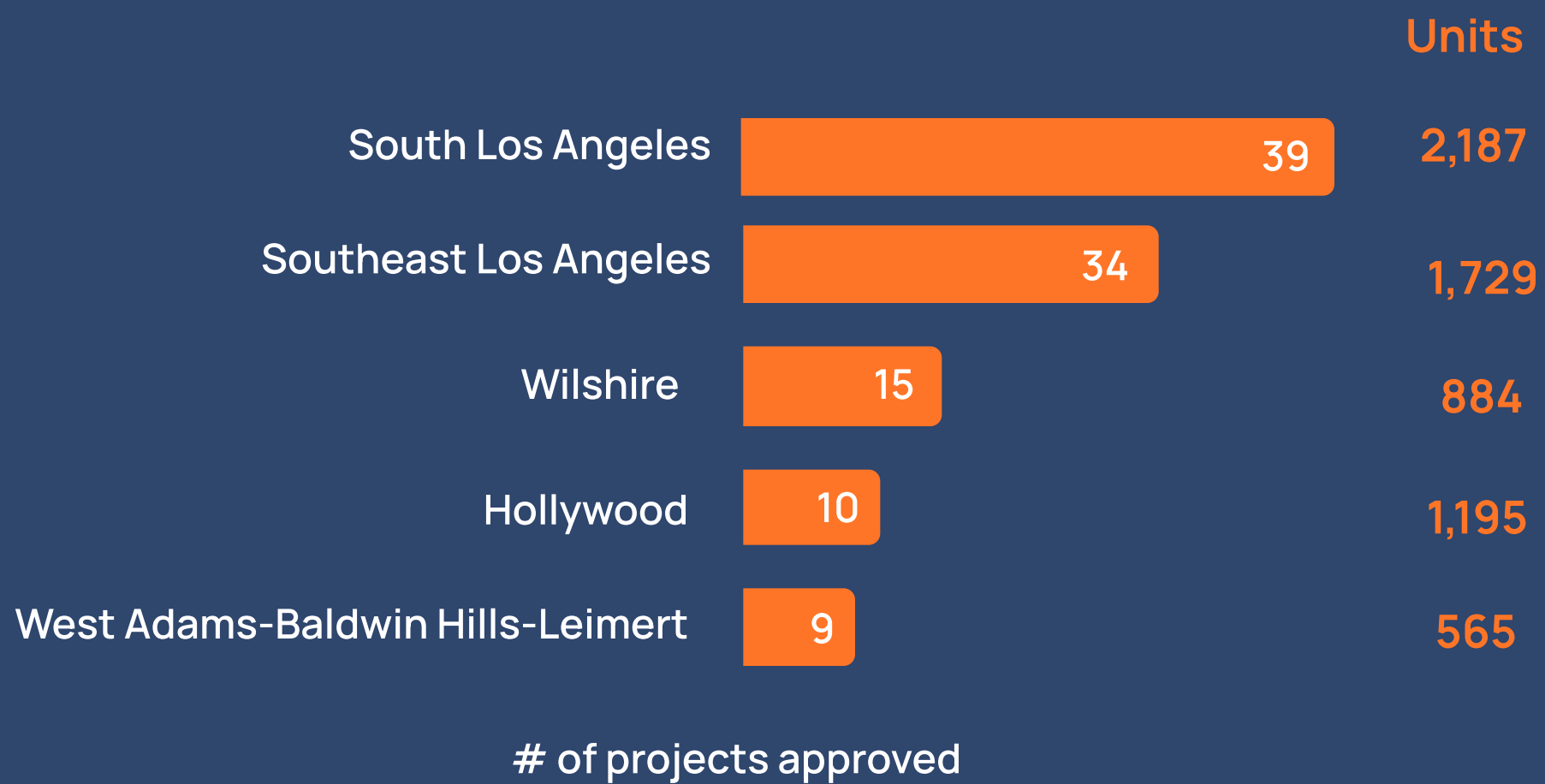


## Where is ED1 housing being approved?
